Pyramids	<p>Create word pyramids using ALL of your spelling words. This activity will give you the best practice for the spelling test. Here is an example of a Pyramid for the word FREE:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> F F R F R E F R E E </p>	6
Poetry in Motion	<p>Create TWO Acrostic Poems using two different spelling words. An acrostic poem uses each letter of a word to begin each line of the poem. Here is an example of an acrostic poem for the word BED:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"> Being comfortable Every night from Dusk until dawn </p>	3
Practice, Practice, Practice	Write each spelling word TEN times.	3
Word Jumble	<p>Choose FIVE different spelling words. For each word, mix up the letters to try and form as many new words as you can! Here is an example of a Word Jumble using the word PLANET:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">P L A N E T</p> <p>Plan, Plane, Net, Tan, Pan, Nap, Lap, Pet, Pen, Ten, Tap, Tale, Plate, Lane, Pane</p>	3
Short Story	Write a short story, journal entry, or sentences using at least FIVE spelling words. When you use a spelling word in your story, you MUST underline it .	4
Picture Place	Draw a picture for each spelling word. Write the spelling word above the picture	3
