





February 1

Imagine that you had an entire garden. Write about some of the things that you would plant in your garden and why you would plant these things.




February 2

Think about how you act and the things that you do. Write about one thing that you would want to change about yourself to make you a better person.




February 3

Imagine that you were the President. Write about a law that you would want to have to help keep people in your community safe.




February 5

Think about all of the people in your life that you look up to. Write about one person that you would want to be your mentor and why you would choose that person.




February 6
